

Literacy:

The children will be looking at a range of fiction and non-fiction genres, including:

- Recounts (personal, police reports, newspaper reports)
- Short stories with flashbacks
- Persuasive writing and balanced arguments
- Fiction Genres
- Narrative Poetry

Art and DT

In Art, we will be looking at the work of famous British artist, Banksy.

In DT, we will be designing, building and testing our own burglar alarms.

Numeracy:

Children will develop their understanding of number and the number system, with a focus on place value. We will also be looking at key arithmetic skills involving the four operations, as well as working with measure.

There will be a big focus on reasoning, problem solving and fluency in all lessons to prepare children of their SATs and beyond.

Topic

- Our history topic this term is Crime and Punishment: a comparative study of how this has changed between Roman times and today.
- We will be looking at Crime and Punishment from the following eras: Roman, Anglo-Saxon/Viking, Medieval, Early Modern Britain, Victorian and 21st Century and evaluating similarities and differences.
- We will be looking at the key British Value of the Rule of Law

Computing:

Children will be using Scratch to create and debug their own programmes based around the theme of 'Heroes and Villains'.

PSCHE:

Our focus this term is New Beginnings with an emphasis on working together, similarities and difference and rights and responsibilities.

Music:

We will be focusing on singing skills to prepare for performances for Harvest and Christmas. We will be looking and composing our own music using the GarageBand App on the iPads.

Science:

We will be following the National Curriculum for Science in Year 6.

In Autumn A, we will be learning about 'Light and Sight'.

In Autumn B, we will be focussing on Electricity.

Spanish:

Mrs Swales will be continuing to deliver Spanish in Year 6; the children will have the opportunity to build on the skills that they acquired last year.
